

What Is Candymeal?

- A blend of chocolate, pasta, cereal, crackers, cookies, breads, sugars, nuts & other foods milled with agricultural commodities to create a finished, high-energy feed component.
- Consistent product tested and monitored regularly since 1987.
- Typically used as a replacement energy source for corn, cottonseed, bakery by-products, molasses, and any other sugar or fat source in the ration.
 - Inclusion rates 2-6 lbs/cow/day (work with nutritionist for optimal results)
 - Replaces cottonseed* pound for pound in ration

*Comparing current historic cottonseed prices in the northeast candymeal delivers savings of approximately \$75/ton in feed costs.
- Proven to increase butterfat and protein components in milk while increasing dry matter intake (DMI).
 - For every 1,000 cows, feeding candymeal adds \$7,533 in the milk check monthly
- Sustainable alternative for organic by-product from food manufacturers by upcycling more than 100,000,000 lbs of by-product last year alone.
- Transportation price quotes are fast and economical addressing needs such as auger, walking floor, belt trailers, etc.
- Storage needs include protecting it from moisture in a commodity bay or bin.
- Common shelf life of 2 months if stored appropriately.
